The students can take the following courses at our Faculty: History, Geography, Philosophy, Social Sciences (Anthropology, Sociology, Political Science) and Languages (English, Spanish, Portuguese, French, Italian, Chinese, Japanese, Linguistics, Hebrew, Russian, Arabic, etc)
Are there any departments/courses not open to our exchange students?	Yes, all courses offered to our first year students.
Could you explain us your credit grading system in full?	<p>Undergraduate (Graduação) grading system at USP ranges from 0,0 (zero) to 10,0 (ten), where zero is the lowest grades and ten is the highest one. To pass a course, a student must fulfill two conditions: minimum score of 5,0 (five) and minimum attendance of 70%. The score represents an average of all work developed by the student.</p> <p>Each Professor has his/her own criteria for exams and work to be developed by the student. That information is detailed by professors in the first class of the course. If the final student score is between 3,0 and 4,99, he/she will be given a chance for re-evaluation: he/she still has a chance to pass. This is called REAVALIAÇÃO (Revaluation). If the final student score is below 2,99, then he/she failed the course.</p> <p>Post-Graduate (Pós-Graduação) grading system is based on four grades: A, B, C and R, where A, B and C are passing grades, and R is a failing grade. Minimum attendance required is of 75%. Registration in Post-Graduate courses is allowed only for foreign students attending the M2 in their home institutions. Students in M1 cannot attend Post-Graduate courses.</p> <p>USP Credit System:</p> <p>USP academic credit system is based in Class Credit (Class work), and Work Credit. One class-credit is equal to 15 hours of class work, or class contact hours.</p>
