Up-to-date transcripts. - Photocopy of passport valid for at least six months. - Certificate of Spanish or English language knowledge, if required, stating that you will be capable of communicating and performing with no difficulties during your academic activities. - Standardized Subjects Form. The student must indicate the subjects they want to study at EAN University according to our academic offerings.

The student's attendance is mandatory during the first week of classes. (We recommend the students to attend the induction classes four days before starting classes).
