Entry Requirements



GPA

GPA of 2.5 or higher is preferred on a 4.0 scale

Language Proficiency

Visa Application

Non-Japanese nationals who wish to study in Japan are required to have a 'student visa' for the duration of their exchange program.

After the application for the exchange program is officially accepted, KUFS will send an acceptance letter and a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) required for the visa application.

Insurance

National Health Insurance

All international students residing in Japan for over 3 months are required to enroll in the Japanese Health Insurance.

Those students holding the Student Visa are required to pay approx. 18,000 yen per year.





Accommodation



KUFS-Owned Residence

KUFS has three student residence managed by the KUFS Housing Support. The KUFS Housing Support will arrange accommodations on a first-come, first-serve basis. Rent must be paid per semester (min. 378,000 yen - max. 420,000 yen).

The details will be sent from the Housing Support after the application procedures have been completed.
