Link Visa	EU citizens can enter Germany without a visa. Non-EU citizens have to get information about how to enter Germany at the German embassy in their home country. Non-EU citizens with residence permit for the Schengen area can enter Germany without visa but will be asked to hand in documents for the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (Information will be given during the application at FAU). Non-EU citizens will have to apply for a residence permit within 90 days after their arrival in Germany. Exceptions are students with visa covering the whole length of their stay.
Assicurazione	German health insurance is obligatory. Accident insurance and liability insurance is highly recommended. All insurances should cover the whole stay in Germany. Exempted from the obligatory German insurance are all students with European health insurance and EHIC. Travel health insurance: non-EU citizens should have travel health insurance at least valid until the start of lectures. Please be aware that international travel insurances are not sufficient and will not be approved by FAU and German authorities.
