BLCU FAQ

1- Exchange student on-campus accommodation.

Exchange students need to submit the accommodation reservation form if you want to live in the on-campus accommodation. Normally, exchange students will be allocated to double room, single room is not guaranteed.

2- Will I have an on-campus accommodation confirmation?

We will not provide any proof of accommodation reservation, but all exchange students' accommodation for double room is guaranteed if you submit the accommodation reservation form.

3- On-campus accommodation fee.

Double room: 80 RMB/day

Single room: 145 RMB/day

4- Accommodation payment method.

By cash or by debit card (union pay, visa, master) when you check-in. If by cash, it should be in RMB; if you use an international card, the bank will charge you a 2.5% bank fee.

5- When can I check-in?

Due to limited amounts of room, students are advised to check in 1-3 days before the course starts and check out 1-3 days after the course finishes.

6- When shall I come to China?

All international students shall arrive no more than one week before registration period, as you will need to register with the authority within 30 days upon arrival through our university, and change to a resident permit to study here, you could not do it by yourself. If you arrive too early, you are facing the risk to be deported if you are not able to register with the authority and get the valid residence permit. This happened before, it is regulated by law, so I suggest the students come to China as required.

7- If I have done the medical check at home country, do I need to do it again in China?

All international students are required by the authority to do the medical check in China at the designated hospital. If you have done it before at home country, you could bring your medical check result to China and shown it to the medical check institution. Please note that you will be asked to do some check, if your medical check at home country does not cover all check needed in China.

8- If I have the insurance already, do I need to buy the medical insurance again in China?

All international students are required to buy the international students medical insurance, which is around 800RMB for an academic year and 400RMB for a half academic year.

9- Does your university offer accommodation like students residences on campus and university canteens?

We have on campus accommodation for international students, if they want to live in it, they need to submit an accommodation reservation form when they submit the application documents.

Student canteens are opened to all students, they could use the student card to pay for the meals as long as they add money in it.

10- What are the language requirements, in English or Chinese, to assist to the class?

We don't have specific Chinese language requirement, but they will take a test at the beginning of the semester, and they will be allocated to different classes based on their test level.

11- What kind of Academic Recognition do you use?

The full test score is 100, and 60 is pass. The students will obtain 20 credits each semester if they pass all classes, 20 credits equal to more or less 20 hours of study each week.

Suggestions and Reminders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The transcript and proof of presence must be provided by the school and must be stamped with the school's official stamp or the responsible person's signature. The letter of recommendation must have the full name and contact information of the one who writes it. ● It is recommended to bring at least CNY 1000 in cash, as it will be needed for the taxi ride to the school and the dormitory deposit. ● Students who come to NKU through an exchange program do not need to pay tuition fees at any school. If there are any questions please consult with the Office for International Academic Exchanges - International Students' Section. ● Please keep in mind that exchange students need to purchase Chinese Medical Insurance(来华保险). Compensation from foreign-based insurance can take longer than from local-based insurance, and because the Chinese medical system requires payment before administering treatment, delays in compensation can have serious ramifications in the event of serious injury. In line with this new policy, students arriving in China will be asked to apply for Chinese Medical Insurance through Nankai University within their first week in the country. The insurance fee is 500CNY for six months or 100CNY for a year. For those who would like more specific information about the Chinese Medical Insurance, please follow the link: http://www.lxbx.net/index-e.html ● In order to transfer credits to your home university, students need to apply to get transcripts at the end of semester, and then need to get their official transcripts from the International Students' Section before leaving China.

- The online dormitory reservations is not available now, therefore the international students' office will make a reservation for students before they come to Nankai. It is not possible to use overseas cards for paying the dorm, It could be paid only with cash or Chinese card. Local banks, when paying for the dorm, student can pay for whatever length of time he/she wishes, the dormitory has different cost standards, which are based on the length of time you plan on staying, either short term or long term. The specifics are as follows:
 - Long-term (3 months and over): 60 RMB/day
 - Short-term (1- 3 months): 65 RMB/day;
 - Regular Price (less than 1 month): 90/104 RMB/day.
- We open most of our Chinese-taught courses to international students. (In order to get your credit, you can choose at most two majors, one of which would count as your main major; you can also take two more classes in other colleges, each class 2 credits, a total of 4 credits.) For candidates who would like to take courses in colleges other than at the College of Chinese Language and Culture, a minimum of an HSK level 4 is required. Your HSK certificate will need to be submitted in our online application system, or If you don't have an HSK certificate, please upload a Chinese proficiency certificate that has been recognized by your university or your department with a stamp. This should include the student's name and passport number as well as an explanation about his/her Chinese proficiency.

Among the 1,986 faculties, there are 616 Doctoral supervisors, 734 master supervisors, 714 professors and 805 associate professors, 8 academicians of Chinese Academy of Science and Chinese Academy of Engineering, 5 academicians of The 3rd World Academy of Science, 15 members of the Subject Assessment Division of the Degree Appraisal Committee of the State Council, 12 nationally accredited experts with outstanding contributions, 37 chair professors and 16 lecture professors invited on Yangtze River Scholar Award program, 4 chair professors invited by Tianjin municipality, 36 recipients of National Outstanding Talent Foundation, 9 recipients of Excellent Young Teachers Prize supported by Ministry of Education, 21 winners of the Cross Century Talents Foundation under Ministry of Education, 20 teachers selected by national Millions of Talents Program, 8 teachers awarded by the Ministry of Education with the honor of Outstanding College Lecturers and 3 national famous masters of higher education.
