For a student who has been accepted to KUFS, KUFS will do proxy application for a Certificate of Eligibility (COE). Once the COE is issued, KUFS will send the original COE, together with the acceptance letter, to partner universities by mail (post). International students should obtain a Student Visa at the nearest Japanese Embassy or Consulate upon receipt of the acceptance letter and COE from KUFS.

#### National Health Insurance

All international students residing in Japan for over 3 months are required to enroll in the Japanese Health Insurance. Those students holding the Student Visa are required to pay approx. 18,000 yen per year, covering 70% of your total medical cost, which means that you (patients) can pay only the remaining 30% claimed by your hospital(s) or other medical institution(s).

#### Accommodations

#### **Accommodation Arrangement by KUFS**

KUFS will arrange accommodations only for those who have submitted the application form for accommodations. It should be noted, however, that due to the limited number of dormitory rooms available, it may happen that some of you (international students) will be obliged to live in a KUFS apartment house(s). KUFS will decide what type of accommodation you will be put into. All rooms arranged by KUFS are furnished single rooms. The rent must be paid by credit card per semester (approx. 264,000 - 324,000 yen). The first rent payment (for the 1st semester) is due before coming to Japan, and the second rent payment (for the 2nd semester) is due before the second semester begins. [Pick-up Service]

If you (international students) are moving into an accommodation arranged by KUFS, you are eligible to use our pick-up service. Please refer to the <u>Exchange Program Website</u> for more details.
